Art of the Holocaust May 9

Professor Stephen Feinstein, Director of the Center for Holocaust and Genocide Studies at the University of Minnesota will present a talk accompanied by slides based on his exhibit "The Artistic Memory of the Holocaust." Dr. Feinstein was the guest curator for "Witness and Legacy: Contemporary Art About the Holocaust," at the Minnesota Museum of American Art. The exhibition toured twelve other museum sites across the United States. He was also the curator of a

second art exhibition: "Absence/ Presence: Artistic Memory of Holocaust and Genocide." During the past several years, Prof. Feinstein has lectured on Holocaust-related art at Brandeis University, Harvard Divinity School, College of St. Catherine (St. Paul), and Ohio Wesleyan University as well as in museum settings related to "Witness and Legacy."
